REMINDERS

- Programme only channels tested from your real areas. An untested frequency is not a channel.
- Transmit briefly, listen long. Every second of transmission is a second of location.
- Legal framework: transmitting on amateur bands requires a licence from your national regulator.
PMR446: 500 mW, fixed antenna, type-approved gear. Listening is generally free.
